Poster presentation

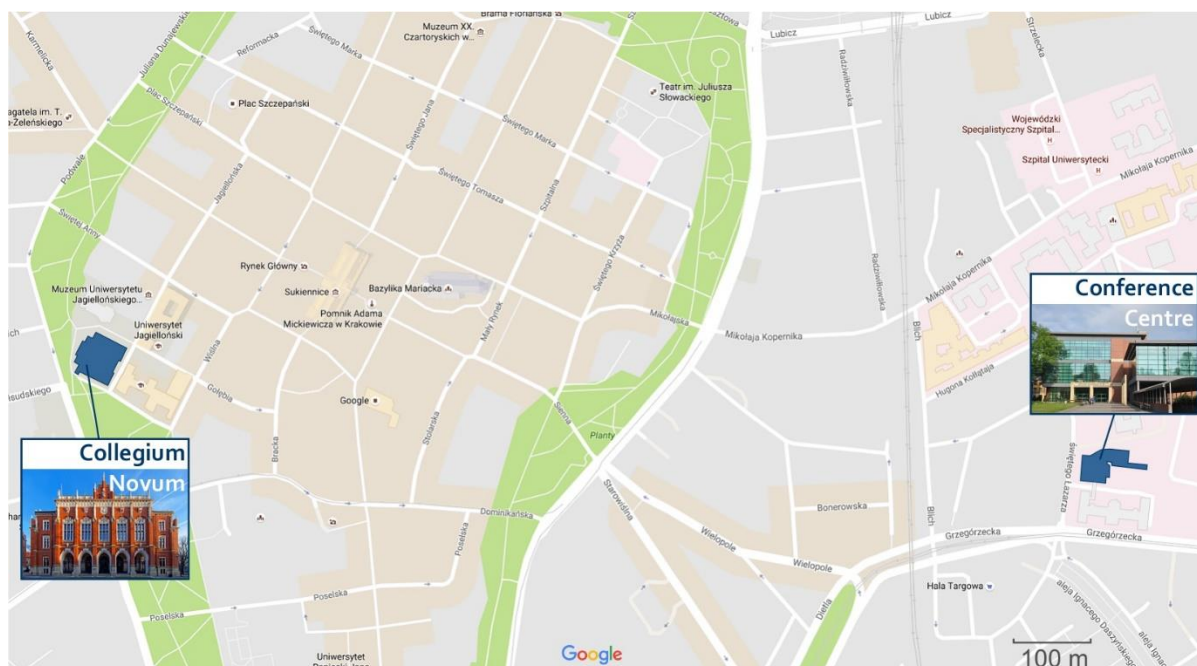
